The Lutheran School of Lexington (LSL) recently completed its first year of classes and we are gearing up for an even better second year. Because of all of the blessings that God has granted to us we cannot stop now – the hard work is far from over.

It is critical for us to receive generous financial contributions this year from as many people as possible.

We are in the process of doing a site survey on the land behind Good Shepherd to determine the possibility of building the school on it. These objectives will require much help from our congregations and their individual members.
